NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **TRENT VALLEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD** proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district during 2018/2019.

Works will involve the re-forming of the banks, some piling to reinforce banks and the installation of access culverts. All works will be carried out on one bank only which will be selected as necessary to minimise the environmental impact, following a technical and environmental survey.
