NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the TRENT VALLEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district in 2016:

Works will involve the removal of kerbs with verge lowering and re-profiling to improve flows from the highways to the Beck. The works are of a limited extent and will have a minimal environmental impact during construction.

The Board considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.
