NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **TRENT VALLEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD** proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district within the financial year 2014/2015:

Works will involve the reforming of the banks of the above watercourses unless otherwise stated. All works will be carried out on one bank only which will be selected as necessary to minimise the environmental impact, following a technical and environmental survey.

The Board considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.
