NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **TRENT VALLEY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD** proposes to carry out improvement works on the following watercourses in the Board's statutory district during 2017.

Works will involve channel improvements and a new culvert together with the construction of a berm to increase storage. These works are designed to alleviate flood risk in Sutton On Trent. All works will be carried out on one bank only, the hedge along Bulham Lane will be re-planted.

The Board considers that the proposals are not likely to have a significant effect on the environment and does not, therefore, intend to prepare an Environmental Statement in respect of the works.
