## DRAINAGE RATES AND SPECIAL LEVIES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT, pursuant to the Land Drainage Act 1991, the above Board on the 27<sup>th</sup> January 2022 resolved that the amounts to be raised by means of drainage rates, in respect of agricultural land and agricultural buildings, and special levies on local charging authorities, for the financial year commencing the 1st April 2022 are as follows:

- (i) By drainage rates in respect of agricultural land and agricultural buildings a total sum of £461,516
- (ii) by special levy on Newark and Sherwood District Council a total sum of £666,146,
- (iii) by special levy on Rushcliffe Borough Council a total sum of £327,575,
- (iv) by special levy on Bassetlaw District Council a total sum of £487,346,
- (v) by special levy on West Lindsey District Council a total sum of £46,689,
- (vi) by special levy on North Kesteven District Council a total sum of £38,956,
- (vii) by special levy on Gedling Borough Council a total sum of £27,497,
- (viii) by special levy on Melton Borough Council a total sum of £21,130,

and further, that on the 27<sup>th</sup> January 2022 the Board made a drainage rate of 11.045p in the pound for Area A and 2.071p in the pound for Area B in respect of agricultural land and agricultural buildings for the financial year commencing 1st April 2022.
